

## About Weber State

WEBER COLLEGE was founded at Ogden, Utah, as Weber Stake Academy in 1889 by the Weber Stake Board of Education of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints (Mormon). Expanded to a Junior College in 1922 and in 1933 was transferred to the State of Utah. For the next 28 years it was operated as a state supported junior college with the first junior year in 1962-63, and the first senior year in 1963-64.

On May 15, 1963, the name of Weber College was changed to Weber State College. WSC is a liberal arts college giving degrees in B.A., B.S., and the titles of Associate in Arts, Associate in Science, a Certificate of Completion, and a Certificate of Proficiency.
